

HATE OR BIAS-MOTIVATED INCIDENT REPORTING FORM

If you believe you have witnessed or been the target of a hate or bias-motivated incident or crime on campus or in Isla Vista or while participating in a University-sponsored activity, you may bring the incident to the attention of the assistant judicial affairs coordinator by contacting her directly at the contact information found at the bottom of this page or by filling out and forwarding this form to her.

The assistant judicial affairs coordinator is available to assist you with any questions you may have about your options, the response process, and further referral sources providing assistance. While you are not obligated to use your name, the range of response options available to you and the UCSB community is considerably greater if you do so. If an incident warrants a formal hearing before the Student Faculty Committee on Student Conduct, the victims must be willing to be named and to testify at a closed hearing of the committee.

If you do not know the identity of the person(s) who initiated the incident, please provide as accurate a physical description as you can. Please use additional pages as necessary, and attach copies (save the original for now) of any supporting statements or materials (photos, copies of a letter, print-out of e-mail, etc) related to the incident.
